Vote Pro-Life

How to Make Abortion Unacceptable in our Society is the Real Question for Pro-lifers.

What can a church do to make a positive difference concerning Pro-life in their own area? Each church is different in some ways, for example, size. However, there are things that every church can do in the area of pro-life education:

- Support the local crisis pregnancy center—Where is the closest center and who is the director? It is an evangelistic arm of the local church. What are their needs?
- Invite the director of the Crisis Pregnancy Center to speak at church functions such as a Missions Conference.

- Start a Salt and Light group. This could be as little as one person although a team is better. They put together nonpartisan voting information at both the primaries and the general election, which identifies the candidates who support pro-life. Are we one issue voters? Absolutely not but a candidate who is pro-life most often is also good on all the other issues such as the Second Amendment, less government regulations, free-market business solutions, balanced budgets, etc.
- Have a pro-life table. In a small church, this can be done perhaps once a month while a larger church can easily have a table every week. The Salt and Light team are the ones to head this up. A lot of folks use Heritage House 76 as a great pro-life resource center. http://www.hh76.org/
