

LESSON III: When Things Go Wrong

Aim: **To teach God's love and compassion for the weaker person.**

Feel: **Compassion and concern for those weaker and that life is sacred no matter what.**

Respond: **Care for others.**

Scriptures: **Bear one another's burdens and thus fulfill the law of Christ.**

Readiness Activity: **Blindfold each other and lead each other.**
