## 2 Political positions

- 3 Kashkari has been a Republican his whole life. [7][68] In a 2008 speech to the American Enterprise
- 4 <u>Institute</u>, Kashkari described himself as "a <u>free-market</u> Republican." In 2013 he described
- 5 himself as a "pro-growth Republican". [68] He opposes most of Obama's economic agenda and
- 6 supports cutting business regulations. [69] He has called for cutting Social Security and
- 7 Medicare [70][71] and replacing the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. [72] In 2012, he voted
- 8 against California's Proposition 30, which raised taxes in the state, and for Proposition 32, which
- 9 would have weakened <u>labor unions'</u> political influence. [73] In a March 2014 interview, he praised
- 10 <u>Wisconsin</u> governor <u>Scott Walker</u>'s controversial <u>policies</u> limiting <u>collective bargaining</u>. [74]
- On social issues, he has described himself as <u>libertarian<sup>[75]</sup></u> and "a different kind of Republican", <sup>[69]</sup>
- supporting abortion rights, marriage equality, and a path to legal status for illegal immigrants. [69]
- He voted against <u>California's Proposition 8</u>, which banned same-sex marriage in 2008. [68] In
- 2013, he was one of 131 Republicans who signed a pro-marriage equality *amicus curiae* brief
- submitted to the U.S. Supreme Court as part of *Hollingsworth v. Perry*, <sup>[76]</sup> the case in which
- Proposition 8 was found unconstitutional. Kashkari owns four guns but considers waiting
- periods and background checks before purchasing a firearm to be reasonable. [78]
- On environmental issues, he voted against California's Proposition 23, which would have
- suspended the state law that limits greenhouse gas emissions. [73] He believes climate change is
- real and man-made. He has spoken positively of fracking and offshore oil drilling and
- 21 negatively of California's cap-and-trade program. [79]
- 22 Kashkari cites Paulson, Mitch Daniels, and Jeb Bush as political mentors. [48] He voted for Obama
- in the 2008 presidential election and Romney in the 2012 election. [68]
- 24 In March 2014, Kashkari announced a plan to create jobs in California if elected. The centerpiece is a
- 25 proposal to waive income taxes for 10 years for businesses that move to California or build new
- 26 manufacturing plants there. The plan also
- 27 calls for expanding fracking of oil deposits,
- 28 relaxing environmental regulations, and
- increasing water storage in response to the
- 30 state's ongoing drought. Economists and
- 31 political experts interviewed by the <u>Los</u>
- 32 <u>Angeles Times</u> were skeptical of the plan's
- 33 chances in the Democratic-dominated
- 34 California Legislature and of its potential
- 35 effectiveness were it to be passed. [80]
